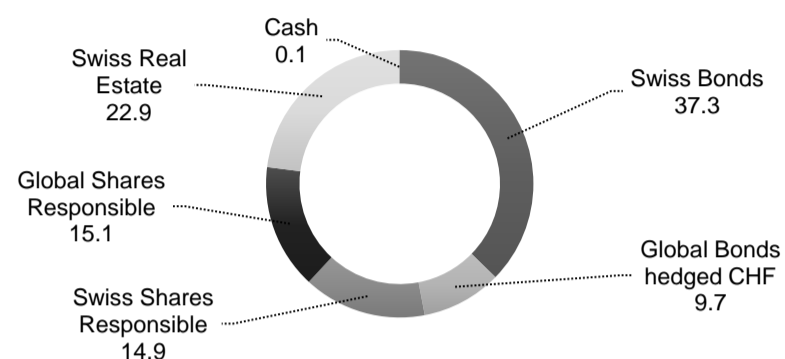

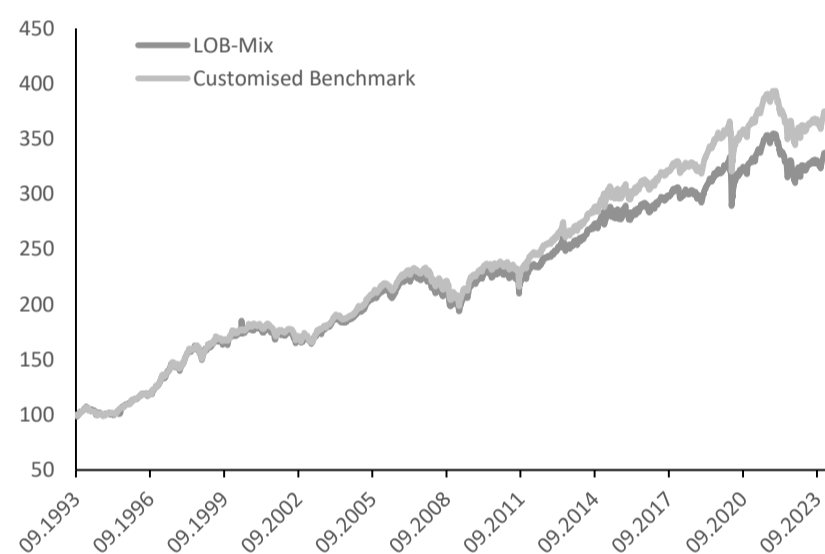
Subscription and redemption
